### WRONG READERS CLUB

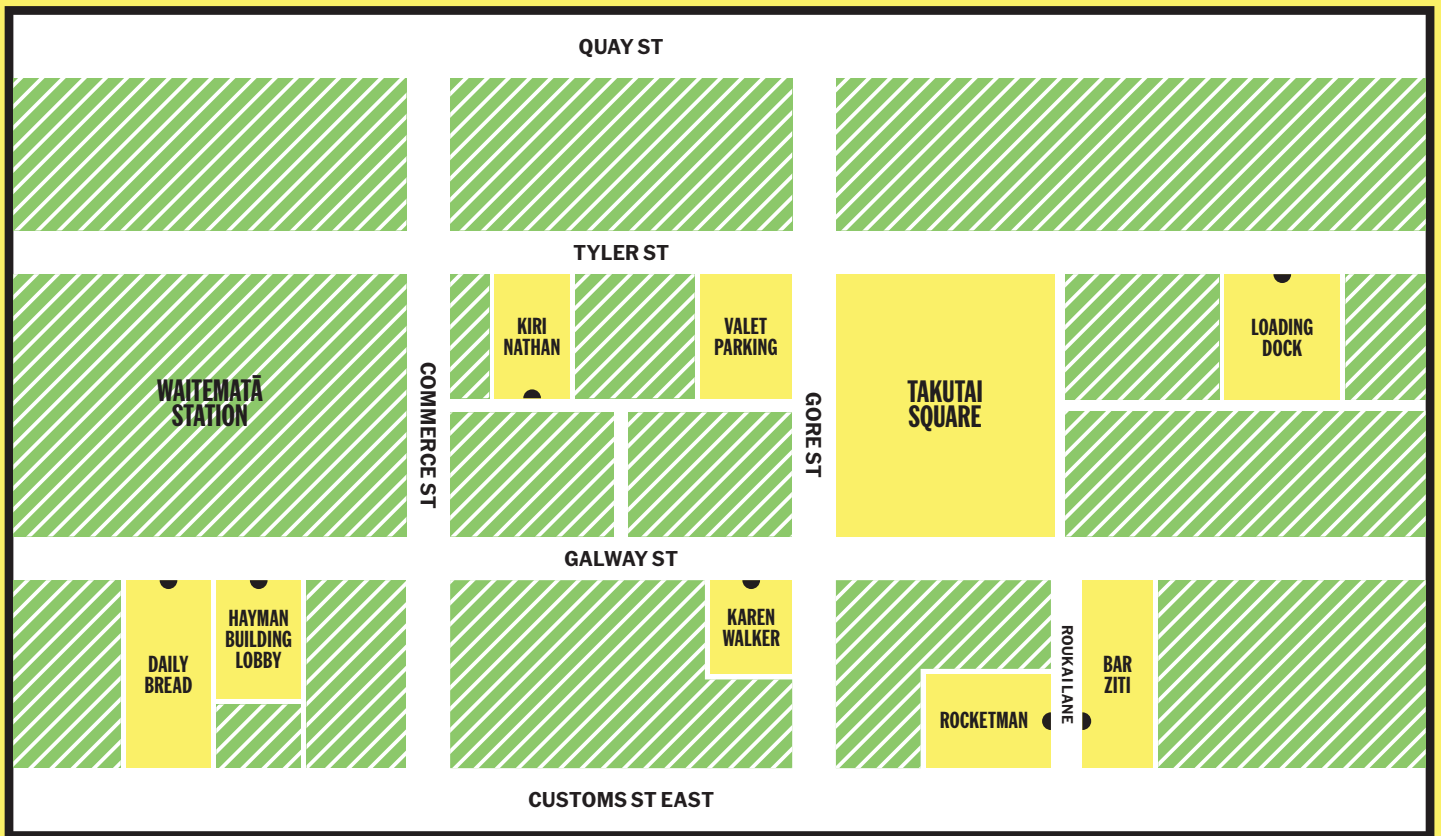
